

WATERCOLOR SEDAR PLATE

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

TC1004A- Coupe Charger TC5506 - Sauce Dish Fan Brush Small Dish For Each Color Water Dish Straw

COLORS

CMM 55- Sea Mist

CMM 42 - Cranberry Sauce

CMM 5 -Coral Reef

CMM 45 - Indigo

CMM 21 - Mango Madness

CMM 27 - Kiwi



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Mix a generous amount of each color with water in a dish. We used 50% water and 50% paint.
- 2. Use a fan brush to dab a puddle of a color on the plate. Use the straw to blow the paint around.
- 3. While the previous color is still wet, add the next color and use the straw again to blow the colors together to overlap.
- 4. Continue your way around until the plate is covered.
- 5. Use small brushes to add splatter and spray by running your thumb over the brush.
- 6. Continue the same process to cover the cups. We used Mango Madness for the rims of all the cups.
- 7. Use a detail brush to add the writing in the center using Cranberry.
- 8. Use a liner brush to add a shadow to the writing using Licorice

TIPS

- Make sure to water down your paint when bubbling, we recommend 75% water to 25% paint
- You only need a drop of dish soap, trust us.
- Keep yourdish level as you scrape off the bubbles, this will avoid all that watered down paint from spilling all over your piece.
- Tap the baby bubbles on the side of the straw onto the piece, they're adorable.
