

DAD'S L'IL ROCKSTAR BOWL

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

DB21446 Cereal Bowl Medium Brush Detail Brush Fan Brush NCR Pattern Water Based Marker Pen

COLORS

CMM 35 - Carribean Blue CMM 11 - Blue Lagoon CMM 73 - Honeycom CMM 25 - Safari CMM 31 - Licorice CMM 44 - Battleship



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Apply the NCR pattern to the side of the bowl using a pen to firmly trace over the lines.
- 2. Paint the foot with a generous coat of Caribbean Blue and print it inside the guitar.
- 3. Use a detail brush to fill in the head of the guitar with 3 coats of Safari.
- 4. Next, paint in the neck of the guitar with 3 coats of Honeycomb.
- 5. Fill in the outside section on the body of the guitar with 3 coats of Caribbean Blue.
- 6. Paint the inside of the bowl with 3 coats of Blue Lagoon using a fan brush.
- 7. Use the detail brush to apply the details on the body of the guitar. One heavy coat will suffice.
- 8. Add water to the Licorice paint, 50% water to 50% paint. Create a messy broken outline around the guitar.
- 9. Use a marker to sketch out the writing and music notes.
- 10. Finally fill in the words and notes with one coat of Licorice using the detail brush.

TIPS

- 3 coats of paint will give you a solid color.
- Make sure to include the child's name and age to the piece.
- We are going for a messy broken outline, so don't worry about it being perfect.
