

NO TRICKS JUST TREATS TREAT JAR

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

CCX069 XL Canister w/ Seal

NCR Pattern

Red Pen

Liner Brush

Fan Brush

Small Round Brush

Medium Round Brush

COLORS

CMM 101 - Fresh Heather

CMM 69 - Carrot Juice

CMM 22 - Gecko Green

CMM 104 - Orange Juice

CMM 41 - Perfectly Purple

CMM 92 - Ghostly Grape

CMM 31 - Licorice



INSTRUCTIONS

- Start by thinning down the Fresh Heather paint by adding 50% water to 50% paint.
 Load up the fan brush and sweep the brush back and forth across the outside of the
 base of the canister. Repeat for a second layer. Allow the plate to dry for a few
 minutes.
- 2. Using a fan brush and the same watered down Fresh Heather paint to paint the main part of the lid.
- 3. Next, we are going to trace on the NCR patterns to side of the canister. Starting with the words, use a red pen to firmly trace over all of the words. Before you remove the pattern, hold it in place on the corner and peel back the pattern to check and see if you've traced on all of the lines. Next, trace on the different candies around the remainder of the the canister.
- 4. Use a medium brush to paint the knob on the lid with 3 coats of Carrot Juice.
- 5. Paint the rim of the lid with 3 coats of Gecko Green using a medium brush.
- 6. Use a detail brush to apply 1-2 heavy layers of Orange Juice to the "no treats....just" words.
- 7. Fill in the "treats" letters with 3 coats of Perfectly Purple using the small brush.
- 8. Paint in the candies with 3 coats of the desired colors: Perfectly Purple, Ghostly Grape, Orange Juice, Carrot Juice, Gecko Green.
- 9. Use a liner brush and Orange Juice to paint lines on the knob to make it look like the lines on a pumpkin.
- 10. Dip the handle of the small brush in Gecko Green paint. Tap the handle of the brush on the top of the knob to create the stem on the pumpkin.
- 11. Create the face on the knob using a detail brush and Licorice paint.
- 12. Thin down some Licorice paint with 50% water to 50% paint. Use the liner brush to create the outlines and details around the candies. These lines should be imperfect and messy to be more whimsical.

TIPS

- The harder you push on the brush, the heavier the line will be. When you're using the liner brush, use the tip of the brush and very light pressure.
- When outlining the candies, don't aim for perfect lines. These are supposed to look fun and whimsical.
