

PASTEL BOO CAULDRON

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

BI 2395 Hocus Pocus Cauldron
Detail Brush
NCR Boo Pattern
Fan Brush
Water Based Marker

COLORS

CMM 67 - Snowflake
CMM 86 - Pretty In Pink
CMM 14 - Gumdrop
CMM 3 - Carnation
CMM 7 - Blush
CMM 93 - London Fog



INSTRUCTIONS

- Load up a fan brush with both Snowflake and London Fog.
 Sweep the brush back and forth on the outside of the cauldron, allowing the colors to blend together. Repeat for a second coat.
- 2. Next, load up the fan brush with Pretty in Pink and paint 3 heavy coats to the inside of the cauldron.
- 3. Allow the cauldron the piece to dry for a few minutes.
- 4. Trace on the NCR pattern to the side of the cauldron. Use a red pen to firmly trace over all of the lines. Before you remove the pattern, hold it in place on the corner and peel back the pattern to check and see if you've traced on all of the lines.
- 5. Paint each letter of the word with 2 coats of your desired color using a detail brush. Here are the colors that we did; B-Blush, O-Carnation, O-Pretty In Pink, !-Gumdrop.

TIPS

- Pretty in Pink is a translucent color, apply the paint very generously to get a more even coverage.
- The hard your push down on the brush, the thicker the line will be. So when you're using the detail brush to paint the letterns, use gentle pressure.
