

PINK-MAS TREES

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

CCX3082 Triple Tree Lantern
Fan Brush
Medium Brush
Sponge

COLORS

CMM 16 - Chiffon CMM 86 - Pretty In Pink CMM 66 - Pink Berry SG3024 - Snowfall



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Use a fan brush to apply one coat of Pink Berry all over the outside of all of the trees. Allow the paint to dry.
- 2. Wipe off the excess paint using a damp sponge. Wipe against the grooves on the tree to leave the pink in the crevices.
- 3. Paint two coats of Chiffon on the center tree using a fan brush.
- 4. Use a fan brush to apply 2 coats of Pretty In Pink to the two smaller trees.
- 5. If desired, add snow to the trees. We used a textured snow called Snowfall. This could also be done with just white paint. Dip your medium brush into the snowfall and tap on to the edges of the trees where desired.

TIPS

- When you're wiping off the Pink Berry on the trees, rinse off your sponge frequently.
- Apply the snow in a tapping motion to put on a generous layer.
- If you're using Snowfall it will get fluffier in the kiln.
